

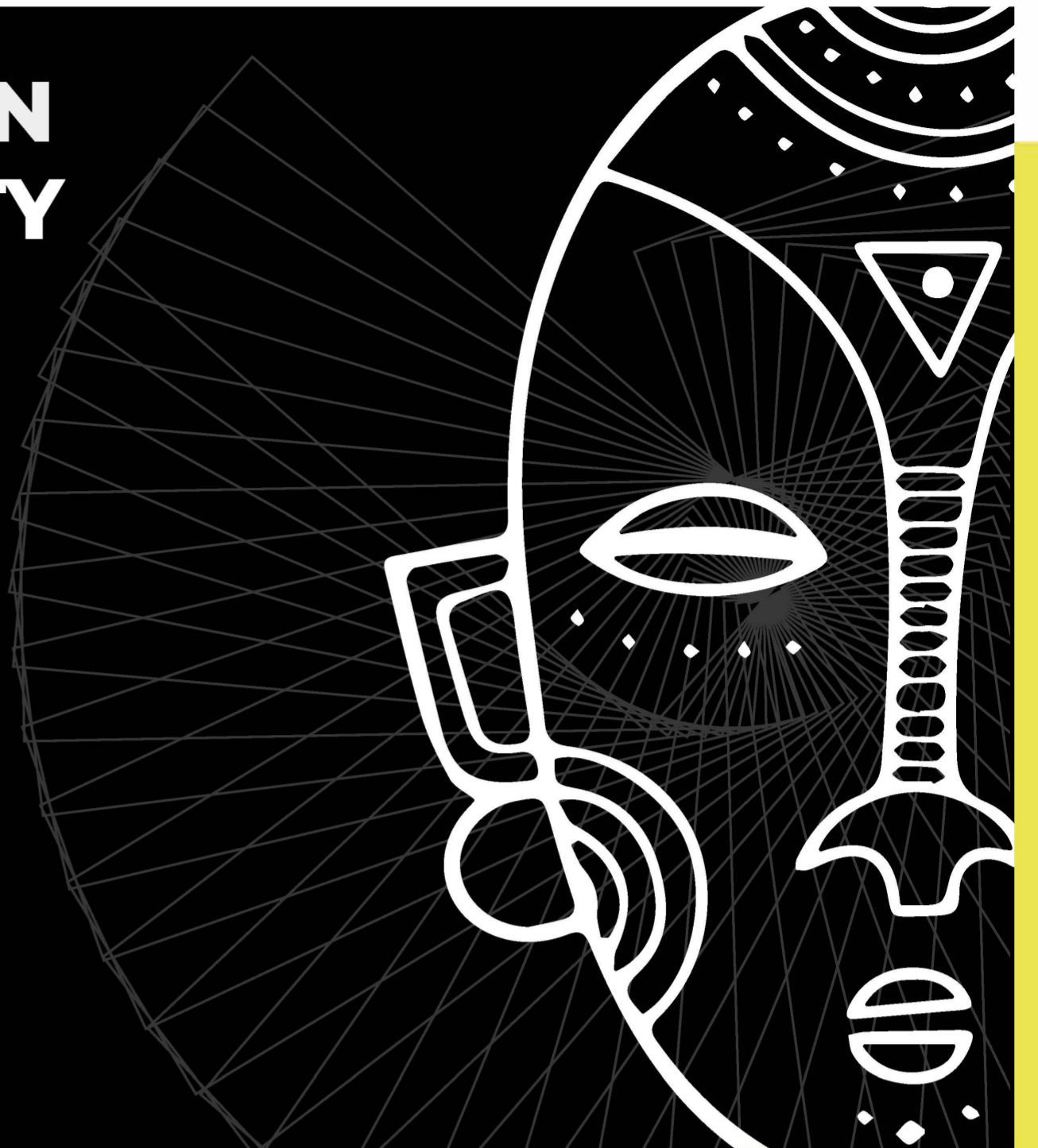
THE CULTURE APP
