TRAINERS BIO

Angela Balzano

Angela Balzano is Coordinator and Professor of the Science module of the Master in Gender Studies and Policies at the RomaTre University; adjunct professor of the course in Diversity Management and tutor in Women and Law for the GEMMA Master in Gender Studies at University of Bologna; She has been research fellow for the Department of Political Culture and Society of the University of Turin, for which she followed the H2020 Project "MINDtheGEPs" (Modifying Institutions by Developing Gender Equality Plans). She was also research fellow for the University of Bologna, where she followed for four years the H2020 Project "PLOTINA: Promoting Gender Balance in Research, Innovation and Training". She has translated for DeriveApprodi Rosi Braidotti (The posthuman) and Donna Haraway (The Promises of Monsters). In 2021 she has published her first monography for Meltemi, *Per farla finita con la famiglia. Dall'aborto alle parentele postumane*.

Krizia Nardini

Krizia Nardini, (Ph.D) serves as researcher, consultant and trainer in the field of gender justice, feminist epistemologies and sexual health. With a background in Philosophy and Gender Studies (MPhil, Utrecht University), she obtained her PhD in Anthropology in 2019 (UOC, Barcelona) working on feminist theories and anti-sexist masculinity politics in Europe. Her work is situated at the intersections of academic, knowledge transfer and social intervention fields. Beyond academic research, Krizia works as trainer of trainers, community educator and gender justice advocate. She is an active member of the network MenEngageEurope since 2015, of MenEngageIberia (2018) and of the steering committee of the American Men's Studies Association. In her current project she combines gender-transformative and embodiment-based approaches for sexual health education and VAW-prevention. She is currently a postdoctoral researcher at the Department of Public Health at the University of Alicante, working within the PositivMasc EU project.

Ilenia Picardi

Ilenia Picardi (PhD in Mind Gender Language, PhD in Physics) is Assistant Professor in Sociology at the University of Naples Federico II (UNINA), Italy. Her research activity focuses on social studies of science and technology, and intersectionality in research and academia. She has been participating in several European research projects in the field of Science in Society. For UNINA, she was project manager of the FP7 GENOVATE Project (Transforming Organizational Culture for Gender Equality in Research and Innovation, January 2013 - June 2017). Within the GENOVATE project, she designed and implemented the Gender Equality Action Plan for the UNINA and was project Coordinator for the first mentoring programme for women in science within Italian universities. Currently she is the person in charge of Science and Technology Studies within the Gender Observatory on University and Research at UNINA and project Coordinator of the Athena Mentoring Program at UNINA. In the last years, she has published several book chapters and papers in Italian and international peer-reviewed journals, and she is author of two research monographs and two science communication books.
